## **Community Advent Services**

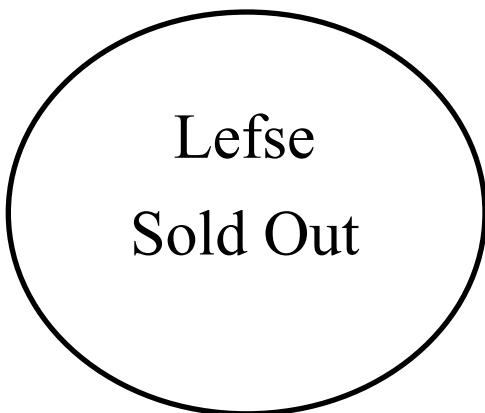
St. Paul's will be hosting two of the three advent services:
